Antony Alpers: 1919-1997

Antony Alpers was a native of New Zealand, born and educated in Christchurch. He enjoyed a successful career as a journalist, music critic, editor, teacher, university professor, and most notably as a biographer and historian. His books include the acclaimed *Katherine Mansfield: a Biography* (1953), the groundbreaking *Dolphins* (1960), his definitive study *Maori Myths and Tribal Legends* (1964), and *Legends of the South Seas* (1970; reissued 1987 as *The World of the Polynesians*). He was a modest man of broad learning and quick wit whose contributions to academia are still felt.
